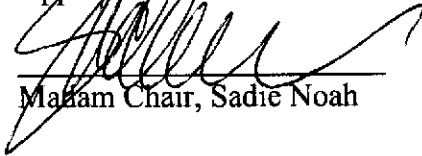
Roll call: Madam Chair Noah, Commissioner Erikson, Commissioner Olson

The motion passed unanimously and the commissioners entered Executive Session per **Idaho Code § 74-206 1(b)** at 4:36p.m.

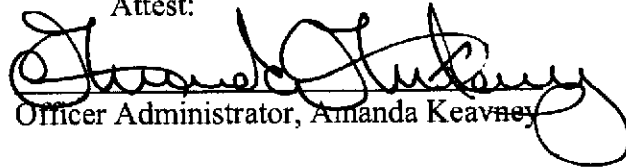
Madam Chair Noah brought the commissioners out of Executive Session per **Idaho Code § 74-206 1(b)** at 5:46pm
